Program Title: Exploring Education in South Carolina & New Zealand

Locations: New Zealand

Dates: May 10-31, 2023

Program Description: Students will examine the public education system of New Zealand and teacher preparation programs there. With British influence shaping the educational practices of the country, it has grown to become world leaders in many facets of education. Students will spend a week in Auckland, the largest city in New Zealand, followed by five days in the capital of Wellington, the political center of the country. The final leg of the program will be spent on the South Island in the university town of Dunedin. Schools visited will emphasize the use of technology and inclusion of diverse populations. These visits, along with the school visits in the Upstate before leaving and assigned readings, will prepare students for assignment sin which they compare the education systems, teacher preparation, and instructional norms in New Zealand with that of South Carolina.
