Program Title: Wild Semester

Locations: Hermosa, NM and South Africa (Cape Town, Port Elizabeth, Nelspruit, Kruger)

Dates: August 23-December 22, 2023

Program Description: The Wild Semester is a16 week, 4 course program thatimmersesstudents in wilderness, adventure, and environmental biology. Students will live in a remote ghost town on the edge of the Aldo Leopold Wilderness in the Gila National Forest in New Mexico for 12 weeks while taking Conservation Biology, Field Ecology, and Field Zoology. After time off to visit family and friends for Thanksgiving break, students will reunite at Furman before departing for South Africa where the fourth and final courseof the program, African Biodiversity and Conservation, will be taught. The Wild Semesterprogram emphasizes hands-on learning, practical skills for scientists (and conservationists in particular), research experience, exploring career options, and a thorough academic understanding of the course material. Learning takes place 24/7 through lectures, lab exercises, field trips, camping, hiking, and field studies. The program is personally, physically, and academically challenging, requiring students to be prepared, motivated, enthusiastic, and fun!
