## Furman University Study Away Program: Program Expectations

Program Title: Queer Histories Locations: San Francisco, CA Dates: May 10-31, 2023

Program Description: Queer Histories (San Francisco) will cover significant moments in LGBTQIA+ history, literature, and culture in the symbolic capital city of LGBTQIA+ communities. The course will cover topics from queer activism of the 20th century to the AIDS crisis, Harvey Milk (including the White night riots), the first Pride parade, the first same-sex marriage license, and many more. After spending the first week of the May X program on campus (where students will do some background work on method, terminology and a general historical overview), students will develop their own research agenda about queer histories by working in two significant archives of the city: GLBT Museum and Archive and Hormel LGBTQIA+ Center. Students will also attend workshops with our guest lectures, visit critical historic sites in San Francisco as a group, and be given time to explore the city on their own. The course will offer students a journey to expand their knowledge of the US and LGBTQIA+ history in San Francisco, the symbolic heart of LGBTQIA+ rights, culture, and history.
