Dates: May 8-29, 2024 food production, procurement and preparation in modern society Readings will motivate discussion on current and historical problems posed by industrial food production; solutions will be considered through the examples offered by traditional foodways as observed and experienced through our residence on an organic farm in Italy and meetings with experts in different facets of food production and consumption Activities regularly include working in the farm's gardens, watching fresh cheese being made, hunting for truffles and other wild foods, visiting an organic winery, and preparing handmade pasta and sauces. Time in Rome at the beginning of the program will give insights into Italians' attitudes about eating and provide the experience of shopping or fresh foods in urban markets.
