## **Furman University Study Away Program: Program Expectations**

Program Title: War & Remembrance: World War I on the Western Front

Locations: England, France, Belgium

Dates: May 8-27, 2024

Program Description: Across England, France and Belgium, students will study World War I and uncover the influence and impact of the Great War through texts, reflective discussions, and memorials. In London, students look to understand how wars are commemorated where no fighting took place through visits to Cenotaph, the Imperial War Museum, and the British Museum to understand the role of imperialism as a cause of WWI. The program will then head to France to see the battlefields such as the Somme, Verdun, Vimy Ridge, Reims (the site of the WWII surrender) and more, before heading to Belgium to concentrate on the area around Ypres. Through the exploration of visiting vast battlefields, walking in existing trenches, and viewing the huge scale of the ossuaries where bones are collected and memorials with tens of thousands of names of the missing, students will come to understand the impact of the Great War.
