Furman University Study Away Program: Program Expectations

Program Title: Ecuadorian Ecosystems: Andes, Amazon, and Galápagos

Locations: Ecuador - Including Quito, Tiputini Biodiversity Station, Papallacta, San Cristobal Island, Santa Cruz Island, and Isabela Island

Dates: May 11-26, 2024

Program Description: This program explores the ecology and biodiversity of three ecosystems in Ecuador: the Andes Mountains (including cloud forests and the Páramo), the Amazon River basin, and the Galápagos archipelago. Participants will observe the marine and terrestrial organisms endemic to this region (including hummingbirds, parrots, primates, sea turtles, sea lions, penguins, and marine iguanas) and will learn about and participate in conservation programs. The action-packed itinerary includes hiking, biking, kayaking, canoeing, snorkeling, and willdlife viewing. Proficiency with Spanish is not required or expected.
