Program: War and Remembrance The Vietnam War Dates: May 13-June 3, 2020

Resources (SOAR)

Course Description: MXP 217b War & Remembrance: the Vietnam War. Examination of the social construction of war-related memory in a specific geographical and historical context through an examination of related monuments, memorials and/or museums. May Experience ONLY. 2 credits.

Program Description: Study the way the Vietnam War has been commemorated and remembered from a Vietnamese perspective. Students will be able to engage and learn through visits to various battlefields including the Khe Sanh, DMZ, Ho Chi Minh Trail, and sites of historical interest such as Hanoi Hilton and My Lai. Students will study and exam of war-related monuments and museums. Students will also experience Vietnamese culture through conversations with local people, a street food tour led by Vietnamese students, and visiting a number of important cultural sites unrelated to the war, including Ha Long Bay, Hoi An (UNESCO World Heritage Site) and Angkor Wat (in Cambodia).
