Program: Sex Goes to School: Sex Ed in the US and Sweden Dates: May 13-June 3, 2020

Course Description: MXP 100: Sex Goes to School: Sex Ed in the US and Sweden. This May Experience class will provide a comparative exploration of sex education practices in the United States and Sweden. Classes will be held at Furman and in Stockholm, Sweden, through a partnership with DIS: Study Abroad in Scandinavia. MayX ONLY. 2 credits.

Program Description: This course is designed to allow Furman students to conduct an in-depth examination of these questions through a comparative exploration of sex education as practiced in the United States and Sweden. The United States and Sweden have very different cultures when it comes to sex education. Students will spend the first few days at Furman, learning from local experts about how sex ed is conducted in the U.S., with a particular focus on South Carolina. Students will then travel to Stockholm and be exposed to Sweden's comprehensive sex education program. Students will hear from experts on gender, sexuality, and sex education in Sweden, and visit local clinics, lobbying groups, and nonprofits.
