Program: Marine Biology and Ethnobiology of Belize Dates: Spring Semester

Program Description: This is a field-riented program that will be taught on campus from January through March, and in Belize for the last month of the spring semester. Students will take 4 courses on campus. In Belize, ee will emphasize the biodiversity, ecology, and physiology of marine organisms, especially as they relate to organism adaptation to the environment; emphasize human influences on the marine environment; study ways in which people understand and participate in human-plant-animal-natural interactions. Most days in Belize are spent snorkeling along the second-largest Barrier Reef in the world with expert guides; thus, all students must be comfortable swimming and snorkeling in the open water.
