Program: Health & Medicine in The Global Context (Portugal)

Course Description: This global clinical course is aimed to provide students an opportunity to examine health care delivery while observing clinical practice in a geopolitical context different from that of the United States. The course will center on clinical practice and analyze social determinants affecting service delivery, patient experience, and health outcomes. Students will start in Greenville to establish a comparative perspective before departing to Portugal to begin AAMC-compliant clinical observations in conjunction with Atlantis. This course provides an opportunity for students with aspirations of attending health professional schools to gain clinical exposure and firsthand experience to drive comparative analyses of healthcare models. By application only.

Program Description: Students will start in Greenville to establish a comparative perspective before departing to Portugal to begin AAMC-compliant clinical observations in conjunction with Atlantis. While in Lisbon, students will spend a minimum of 20 hrs/week in the hospital environment, shadowing doctors in pairs. They will shadow four days per week, generally between 9am -2pm, although the hours will change depending on the day and hospital activity. One weekday per week is reserved for an Atlantis-organized group excursion of cultural, regional, or historical interest. Students will shadow in a variety of medical fields inside the hospital – surgery could be included. This is
